Dr. Stokes earned his medical degree from the University of Kentucky College of Medicine at Lexington. He completed internship and residency training in pediatrics at Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, Md. He served as a research fellow in pulmonary diseases at Children's Hospital Medical Center and completed fellowship training in pediatrics at Harvard University Medical School in Boston, Mass.

Dr. Stokes also holds a master's degree in public health. He serves as professor of pediatrics at the University of Tennessee Health Science Center in Memphis. He is board certified by the American Board of Pediatrics, sub-board of Pediatric Pulmonology. He has a special interest in asthma, bronchoscopy, cystic fibrosis, exercise problems, pulmonary function testing and pulmonary infections.
