NMMC PULMONOLOGISTS EARN BOARD CERTIFICATION

TUPELO, Miss.—Two North Mississippi Medical Center pulmonologists have achieved board certification through the American Board of Internal Medicine.

David Reed, D.O., passed the new sub-specialty board certification examination in sleep medicine. Paul Perry, M.D., passed the board certification examination in pulmonary medicine.
