**NMMC TO HOST WOMEN'S HEALTH,  
NEWBORN & CHILDREN'S CONFERENCE**

TUPELO, Miss.—North Mississippi Medical Center will host a Women's Health, Newborn and Children's Conference on April 19-20.

Sessions will meet from 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m. both days in NMMC's North Education Center, 830 S. Gloster St. The conference is targeted toward physicians, nurses, dietitians, social workers, therapists and pharmacists involved in women's basic health care, obstetrical/gynecological, newborn and/or children's health.

Monday's topics include breast cancer, drug use during pregnancy, common neonatal surgical problems, obesity sensitivity, breastfeeding, child advocacy, menopause and domestic violence. Tuesday's topics include pelvic pain, trauma during pregnancy, developmental delays, sexually transmitted diseases, methadone and pregnancy, cultural sensitivity and infertility. Janie Walters of Champion Communications will deliver the closing session on "The Little Engine Did, And So Can You!"

The conference is free to NMMC employees but pre-registration is required. For other participants, the registration fee is \$60 for one day or \$100 for both days.
