The research so far shows that for certain people, taking Casirivimab/Imdevimab may help limit the amount of virus in the body.

This may help your symptoms improve sooner and reduce your need to go into the hospital.

- This is a one-time treatment you receive through an IV or SubQ.
- The treatment will last about one hour, and we will want you to stay one hour afterward.
- No visitors are allowed in the treatment area. If someone drove you, please have your driver leave contact information so he/she can be called when your treatment is almost complete.
