



The NMMC Mentorship Academy is a model program created by the Mississippi Office of Nursing Workforce. The Academy targets students with interest in nursing or other health care careers. Students will be trained and mentored in a state-approved, 80-clock-hour Certified Nursing Assistant program.

The Mentorship Academy will meet from **3-4:30 p.m. on Tuesdays for six weeks beginning March 1, 2022** (skipping Spring Break week). The student will also be required to complete a two-hour shadowing session each of those weeks (to be scheduled after acceptance).
